Mass – All Candidates

- > Regular worship at Mass is the most valuable way to prepare to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- Please attend Mass as often as your health allows.

Catechetical Sessions

- Traditional Candidates.
 - Please commit to one regular session If it is impossible to attend your regular session,
 candidates are welcome attend the other session.
 - Parents/guardians, please notify Anne via email only by 9am Sunday if your teen will be attending the other session. (Please do not call or text regarding absences.) OR please contact Anne for a makeup assignment.
 - Everyone gets two free absences: no need to switch sessions or complete a makeup.
 Use the Christ is Calling card to track these for your records.
- > Catholic School Candidates. Your catechetical content is addressed at school. Their attendance policies apply.

Retreats

➤ All Candidates: Participation in one retreat each year is a requirement. If you are unable to attend the retreat offered for your year at St. Rita Church, you may attend any Confirmation retreat for your year at another Catholic church in the Diocese of Rochester.

Drop-Off + Pickup Procedures

Weekly Gathering Drop-Off

Traditional Candidates

- ➤ **Use entrances 4+13** (the school doors nearest the barn, and between the gym and the school main entrance).
- > ADULTS, PLEASE ENTER THE BUILDING WITH YOUR CANDIDATE
- Adults at sign in:
 - Find your teen's name.
 - o Print and sign your name.
 - Indicate who will be picking up.
- Candidates at sign in:
 - o Bring your Catholic Youth Bible and Catholic Faith Handbook in with you.
 - Take and wear your name tag.
 - o Go directly to your small group's room.

Weekly Gathering Pickup

Traditional Candidates

- ➤ Use entrances 4+13.
- Adults, sign your teen out on the sign in / sign out sheet.
- After you have signed your teen out, please go to their small group location to pick them up.
- Teens whose small group meets in the barn will gather in the gym at pickup for security.

Retreat Drop-off + Pickup

All Candidates

- Please read retreat emails carefully for drop-off and pickup procedures.
- > An adult will be required to enter the building and sign your teen in and out of the retreat.

Please note: Because we will be starting and ending in locations throughout the church/school campus for the first time this year, we may change drop-off and pickup locations while we learn what works best. Adults must sign minors in and out of all drop-off programming per diocesan policy; this will not change.
